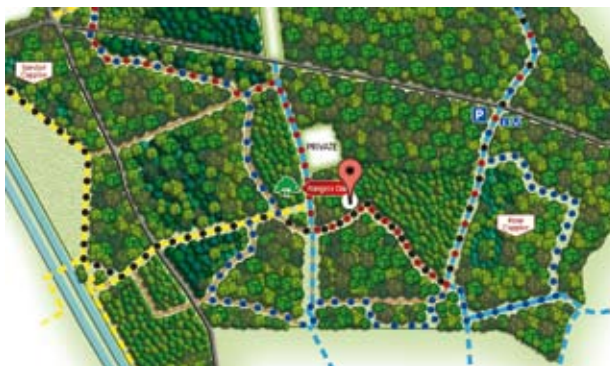

Getting involved ...

Whether you have used other networking sites (like Facebook or LinkedIn) or not, you'll quickly find your way around – just sign up to **getinvolved.ning.com** with a few basic details and get going.

Its really easy to get started, and once you've signed up you can upload images to your own photo albums, leave comments, start or join in a blog or discussion. You'll have your own page and can decide what information you share with others, and what you want to keep to yourself – you are in control.

Just click "Sign up" on the home page and fill in the details



then choose privacy settings to suit your own preferences (you can change these at any time).

Add your own photos

Create your own photo albums and upload images from your computer, from Flickr, or by email - you can use your unique email address to upload images from any computer without having to sign in, or send direct from your phone.

Want to upload some images right now, or want to try it out before you sign up? Email photos to:

(they'll appear in the Photos section under Anonymous – you'll be able to add them to your own album later).

Want to add images direct from your mobile?

Most mobile phones can also be used to send emails, enabling you to add images direct from your phone.

If you haven't already set up your phone to send and receive emails, you'll need the mail settings from your email provider's website (you can usually find these in the Help section).

If you can't see email options on your phone, check your phone manual for specific instructions, or contact your phone company to help you get set up.

Add comments, join in discussions

Add comments, status updates, text notes and much more to your own page. Include a profile picture, change the way it looks, even rearrange the whole page to suit you – its your space, you are in control.

You can also add comments to photos and albums, upload videos, presentations and other documents.

Its easy to join in blogs and discussions. You can include images, videos, text, and add comments to existing blogs – or start your own blog. The discussion forum is a great way to interact with other members – check out the existing discussions, or start your own by clicking the "Start Discussion" link.
